Skooloop have advised the following:

Winter Uniform Next Term (30th April) all students should be in winter uniform.

Girls Green tartan pinafore/skirt. Year 5 & 8 girls wear a skirt at least knee length,

Years 0-4 wear a pinafore which consists of the same skirt as the Years 5-8, but with a bib attached.

White Blouse – Year 5 – 8 girls white school blouse which is a short sleeved blouse with a split hem and

Y4 girls wear a white winter weight school blouse. White ankle or knee-high socks and black leather/waterproof school shoes.

Boys Grey shorts (heavy weight) Grey Polo shirt with logo, long or short sleeved. Grey knee length socks and black leather/waterproof school shoes.

School Jersey/Polar Fleece for boys and girls. This is a regulation green woollen jersey/or polar fleece. (Alternative sweatshirts are not an option.)
